



**MINUTES
SPECIAL MEETING
America250 Coordinating Committee**

**Tuesday, November 25, 2025, 6:00pm

1. Call to Order – Vice Chair Clifford called to order at 6:05pm.

2. Approval of Minutes – Motion to approve the minutes of September 25, 2025, made by Kelly Davis, Seconded by Alex Ranniello. All in favor.
3. State 250 Updates (If Any) – Aaron Marcavitch noted no new state information.
4. Education & Outreach – Aaron Marcavitch provided updates on the Micro-Essay contest. He stated he would work with the schools to document and promote these events to the community.
5. Event Development – Emily Clifford asked that Lucian and Don provide an update on their work around events. They reported that the Veterans Council will be holding a program in January with 1100 invited. This program will be on January 16 and will include recognizing every veteran in the community with a coin and certificate. They asked for potential support for food and for marketing support.

They also reported on the Veterans Parade in 2026. The planning for this event will happen in January. Aaron Marcavitch suggested a lecture about Elijah Churchill in the Scitico Room with snacks and discussion. Lucian suggested potential static exhibits and materials.

Kelly Davis reported on the Abbey Monument process. The dates are still a little fluid but the goal is a “spade turning” in April with a summer dedication. The committee emphasized the need to set a date.

Aaron Marcavitch noted the need to talk with the July 4th committee and set some expectations as soon as possible. Emily Clifford noted the several concerts that are planned.

A lengthy discussion was held regarding the marketing materials needed for this year. Discussion included popup banners, totes, pennants, pens, pencils, wristbands, water bottle, water bottle stickers, and window clings. Also discussed was the Tshirt design. There was a discussion about keeping it simple with the logo in black and white, small on front and big on back. Shirts could say “sponsored by.” The group also talked about a “concert style neighborhood list” on the back. There was a discussion about using the Abbey statute in profile.

The committee also discussed a few ideas such as a “human flag” with drone fly over. They discussed having the Purple Heart Museum at the Veterans Day program. Aaron Marcavitch brought up bringing a 1700s doctor reenactment for presentations. There was a discussion about lectures and programs that might make sense in town.

6. Meeting Schedule – The committee discussed coming in front of the Town Council on February 2. Motion to approve the proposed schedule as amended by Kelly Davis, seconded by Alex Ranniello. All in favor.
