

ENFIELD ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME MINUTES

May 11, 2021

Mike welcomed everyone to the outdoor meeting at the Senior Center. Last month's minutes were read and accepted. The Hall of Fame checkbook balance is \$4,505.53 and the Amy Romano/Field Hockey checkbook balance is \$3,484.38.

Committees:

Fundraising - Except for the golf tournament at Grassmere, nothing else is on the horizon.

Biography - Mike said that Bob Bromage is currently updating this year's bios and said they should be ready for inclusion on the plaques, shortly. Jon asked if this year's applicants have until Dec. 31st to send in bios. The answer, yes.

Scholarships - Nancy reported that 9 scholarships were submitted. Recipients will be announced in June. She also said Marian is currently preparing a video that will be presented when the date for the virtual event is decided upon.

Field Hockey Tournament - Nancy said a tentative date for the tournament is Sunday, Aug. 29th, but the date still needs to be confirmed.

Golf Tournament - The tournament is scheduled for Saturday, Sept. 18th at Grassmere with a noon shotgun start. The cost is \$75.00 for 9 holes which includes a box lunch. We still have all the prizes and donations from the previous year and Joe added that Hopmeadow Golf Club will still honor their certificates. Joe also said that there will be a cap of 18 foursomes and that he will contact Enfield Teachers Association to encourage them to play. Lastly, a motion was made and seconded to charge \$75.00 per person for the tournament instead of \$65.00 which was previously voted on at a separate meeting. The vote was unanimous in favor, 9 to 0.

Banquet - It is scheduled for Friday, Sept. 24th. The evening will start at 5:00 p.m. for the incoming inductees and 5:45 p.m. for the rest of the guests. At last month's meeting a discussion on ticket dispersal ensued. Due to a lack of a quorum, the discussion and decision was tabled until this month. Therefore, the following motions were made and seconded and the following decisions were made: A unanimous decision of 9 to 0 to give the individual inductees two free tickets; a vote of 7 to 2 in favor of giving past Hall of Famers one free ticket; a vote of 9 to 0 in favor of giving the teams one free ticket to each team member; a vote to charge \$25 for each committee member was defeated 8 to 1; a vote to charge the committee members a ticket price of \$40 was approved 9 to 0.

Hall of Fame Website - Mike reported that Carl has updated the nomination page on the website.

Meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m. Our next meeting is scheduled for June 8, 2021 indoors at the Senior Center.
