

ENFIELD ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME MINUTES

October 12, 2021

Mike called the meeting to order at 6:40 p.m. Hall of Fame checkbook balance is \$6,611.46 and the Amy Romano/Field Hockey checkbook balance is \$3,459.38. The secretary's report was accepted as read.

Committees:

Mike then said we may need a maintainer for the site, but that would depend on the cost. He added that his neighbor might be willing to help us out, so he, Carl, and Glenn plan to get together with him to hopefully help us solve our dilemma.

Miscellaneous - Jon gave a large congrats to the golf committee, especially Joe, for a job very well done.
