

**ENFIELD TOWN COUNCIL
MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
MONDAY, May 1, 2023**

A Special Meeting of the Enfield Town Council was called to order by Mayor Cressotti on Monday, May 1, 2023. The meeting was called to order at 5:15 pm.

ROLL-CALL – Present were Councilors Cekala, Cressotti, Despard, Finger, Hopkins, Ludwick, Mangini, Nelson, Pyznar, and Unghire. Councilor Santanella was absent. Also present were Town Manager, Ellen Zoppo-Sassu; Assistant Town Manager, Steven Bielenda; Town Attorney, James Tallberg; Director of Finance, John Wilcox; and Town Clerk, Sheila Bailey.

BUDGET DISCUSSION – Town Clerk Sheila Bailey presented the proposed FY2023/2024 budget for the Town Clerk Department and Records Manager. A copy of the presentation is appended to these minutes.

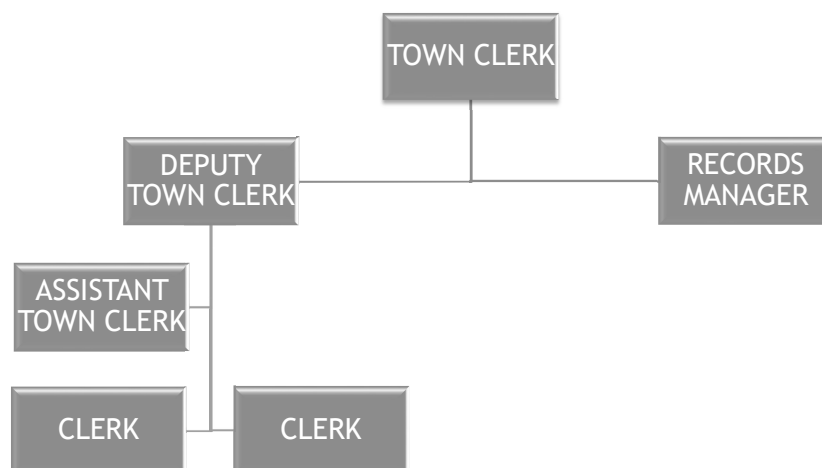

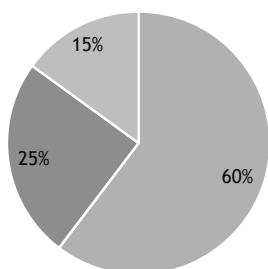

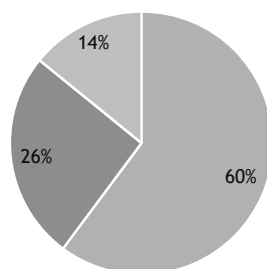

The Record Management Division of the Town Clerk's office is responsible for the planning, organizing, and controlling of a town-wide records management program. This includes the following:

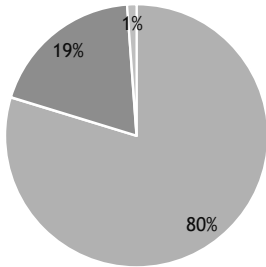
- ▶ The archiving of inactive records

- ▶ Retrieval of inactive records at the request of departments/divisions
- ▶ Assists departments with record management questions and strategies

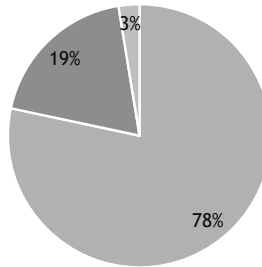
