Chapter II Section 4 – Vacancies

- Clarification based on Commissioner Cremona's questions: We can approve a replacement with fewer than six (6) votes.
- Language also clarifies that the party on the Council will fill Board of Education vacancies of the same party.

Chapter VI Section 4 – Duties of the Council on the Budget

- Discussion of the case where a referendum fails:
 - Decision that it will go back to council, and they will have to meet until something below the 7% threshold is figured out.
 - Commissioner Ludwick confirms we should remove the language "default to manager's budget"
