NEW BUSINESS

Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Town Council Recommended Changes to the Draft Report

Chair Nelson: Stated the Council recommended the referendum trigger be reduced from greater than 5% to greater than 4%.

Commissioner Cremona asked if the Commission voted no on the 4%, does it go back to the Council at 5%. Chair Nelson confirmed that it would.

Commissioner Zannoni stated that he felt 5% was a threshold that all the commissioners could support.

Commissioner Price thanked Commissioners Zannoni, Cremona, and Nasuta for speaking to the Council and voicing how hard the commission worked on this. She reiterated her belief that Town Council members should not have been allowed to serve on the Charter Revision Commission and should not have had the opportunity to vote twice.

Commissioner Dumond stated that he felt it should read “greater than 5% or 4% of the *budget* and not of *expenditures*. Chair Nelson explained that this language was agreed upon after input from the Finance Director.

Chair Nelson stated that he would prefer the threshold was changed to 4% but is not willing to jeopardize the 5%.

Commissioner Dumond stated that 4% would represent roughly a budget increase of \$6M and 5% \$8M. It is a significant difference. Chair Nelson said the current budget's 1% increase resulted in an increase of approximately \$200 for the average resident. A 5% increase would be approximately \$1,000 increase in taxes.

Commissioner Ludwick stated that he strongly disagreed with saying that it was unethical for the Town Council members to serve on the commission.

Chair Nelson called for a show-of-hands vote.

All in Favor of Reducing the Percentage to 4%

Dumond, Nasuta, Ludwick, and Nelson.

All in Favor remaining at 5%

Cressotti, Price, Cremona, Sferrazza, Anderson, and Zannoni.

Approval to Submit the Final Report to the Town Council.
