

Minutes for February 4, Special Meeting, Senior Tax Relief Committee

The special meeting commenced at 2:10 p.m. at the Enfield Senior Center, Conference Room. David Goyette, Mary Keller, Marleen Hoginski, Kay Tallarita, Tyler Devine, John Wilcox, and Victoria Rose are all present. Marie Pyznar, Robert Cressotti, George Young, Mike Arnone are absent.

Ms. Hoginski stated her name on the minutes for January 14, 2025, was incorrect. Her first name is Marlene not Maureen.

Mary Keller stated the application process ended January 31, 2025, and have received 151 applications. Last year 193 applications were received.

Discussion on the clarification of veteran's exemptions was held and determined that the \$400 would be added to the balance of the tax bill.

Review of funding for f/y 2025 and criteria for volunteer organizations. The funding for f/y 2025 was 100,000.

The committee recommends increasing the amount of volunteer hours to 75 hours instead of the current 50.

The Committee feels that the Town Council can debate who is a non-profit organization, if it's only a 501-c (3) or if the organization is for the greater good of the Town. John will write something up and present to the caucus.

The next meeting will only be scheduled if needed.
